



Project Description:

The London Aquatics Centre project was an internal development of a new gymnasium in the upper welcome zone. The London Aquatic Centre is a purpose-made Olympic swimming pool facility that requires further internal development to incorporate different activities. The works consisted of

- Installation of a high level ventilation duct above the inner entrance doors
- Closing of existing double door sets
- Blanking of the glass screens to add Sound Sorba and mirrors
- The strengthening of the floor underneath the computer floor for 5
- No pieces of gym apparatus
- Forming of two dwarf walls either end of the upper welcome zone
- The installation of door automation
- Working on a live distribution board
- located within the buggy park cupboard
- Modifications to the existing lighting
- The introduction of feature lighting
- New wiring circuits for the gym equipment
- The extension of the perimeter heating system
- New floor coverings
- Minor decorations
